

The MCHS faculty has seen the addition of some new faces this year. One face that should be familiar, however, is that of Meg Day.

Day graduated from Howe High School in Howe, Texas, and moved to Tennessee to attend college in Henderson. She was actively involved in sports throughout her high school and college days, playing volleyball, basketball, softball and being a cheerleader. Day earned her teaching degree from Freed-Hardeman.

Day began teaching in 2001 at Bolivar Middle School. The next year, she came to McNairy

Central to work in the Special Education department. After seven years, she transferred to Selmer Elementary for the next seven years. Day then moved to a countywide position, serving three years at that level. For year 19, Day has chosen to return to MCHS.

Day says her decision to become a teacher was heavily influenced by her parents, who were both in education. She works as a Special Education Interventionist and teaches English.

plans for this year.

"She treats us all equal, she doesn't play favorites," said Bodiford. "She's always very encouraging and tells us to work hard and play as a team. I don't know where she gets all her ideas, but I know she watches a lot of videos [of games]."

Daughter Lynleigh is a freshman on the team, her first year playing on mom's school team.


Lynleigh says "We usually talk over the game
