
Students Earn Industry Certification

Trevor Mangrum and Damon Mock have earned the industry certification "Microsoft Technology Associate".


The certification is earned by passing the national exam from Microsoft. There are several specialties offered through the exam. Both students took and passed Exam 98-375, HTML5 Application Development Fundamentals.

HTML5 is the current standard for website design, and is the core structure of the internet. Learning HTML is much the same as learning any foreign language such as Spanish or French; there are syntax rules to be followed. Coders must write their code in a specific way so that the browser software will display the information the way they intended it to. Those rules have constantly evolved over the lifespan of the world wide web, forcing website designers to keep their skills up to date.

Having certification gives students the chance to prove their capabilities to prospective employers,

and gives them an edge over their competitors. The industry certification also qualifies these students as a "Ready Graduate," the evaluation process used by the State of Tennessee for determining a school's effectiveness in a given year.

Mangrum, a senior, plans to major in Computer Science and pursue a career in the computer field. He has taken two years of Website Design, and a year of Programming and Logic while at MCHS, and has completed multiple projects during that time. He is currently working on an alumni database for his senior proj-

ect. The database, when launched, will give MCHS alumni the ability to log in with their own username and password, and enter or update their contact information. This will allow class reunion planning, and provide more networking opportunities among alumni.

Mock, a junior, transferred to MCHS a few weeks into the semester, but quickly proved he had a knack for coding. Mock also plans a career in computer science, and has worked on a website for a local business that will be launched over the Christmas break.
