2020: What You Need to Know

SCHOOL TEXTS

MCHS now uses the OneCallNow system to send texts to students and parents. This is the same system that sends out phone calls on snow days, or with system-wide announcements. MCHS students and parents can update your contact information by using the Self-Update Portal. Go to mchscats.org, click on the Home tab, Get Connected, Sign up for Texts, and follow the instructions. Don't forget the final step!

PARENTVUE

Parents who need access to ParentVUE, the online gradebook, can request your login information by sending an email to "grades@mcnairy.org". Make sure to include your student(s) name(s).

STUDENT IDs

All MCHS students attending in person should have their Student ID card with them at ALL times. They must use their ID card to sign into the lunchroom for breakfast and/or lunch. They will also need it to check out books in the library.

Any student attending in person who has not received an ID should check first with their homeroom teacher, then with Ms. Forsythe.

PROJECT ENRICH (AFTER SCHOOL)

The After School program will begin on Tuesday, Sept. 8. Students must complete the green registration form in the office or from Mrs. Hays (D11) to participate. ReConnect students are

allowed to attend after school on the condition that they are registered with the after school program (green registration sheet).

Students may make up tests, get tutoring help, or complete assignments they are behind on while in after school. See the schedule below.

VIRTUAL SCHOOL

MEDICAL POLICY
