After discussing “cell phoneography” in journalism, the students were assigned a six words, six shots poster board assignment.

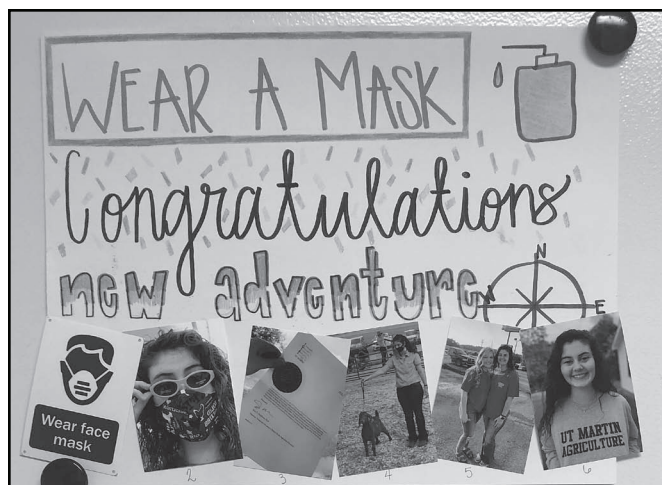

the pot was assembled, Hemingway wrote the following six-word story: “For sale, baby shoes, never worn.” Hemingway won the bet.

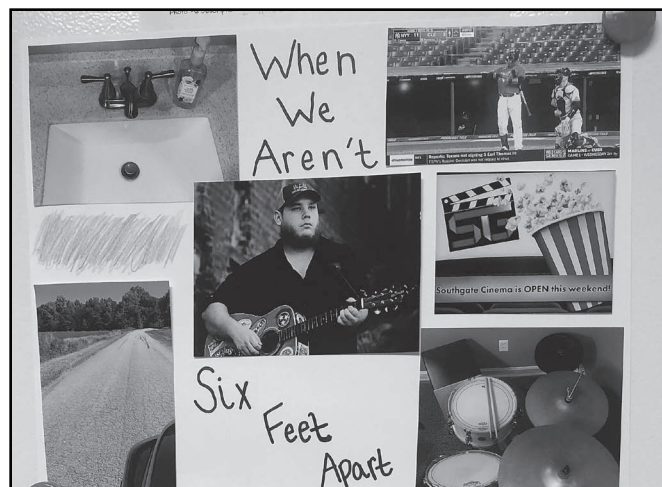
Students were challenged to create their own six-word story and then shoot/print six photos to go along with the story. The story was to summarize their summer, COVID-19, and/or the school year.



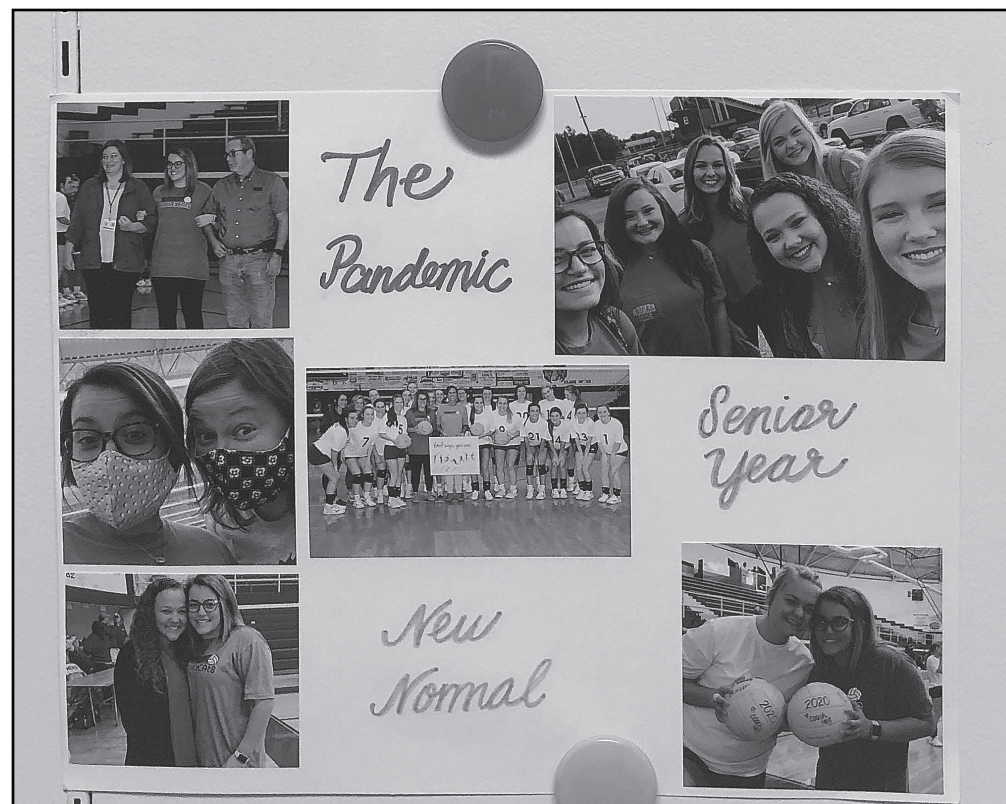
