## **Administrators Prepare for Intruder Drill**

Tentatively scheduled for January 21, 2022, the MCHS Administration and Law Enforcement personnel will conduct an "Intruder Drill" on campus. The purpose for this drill is to ensure MCHS staff perform an accurate initiation of the steps to follow in the event that an intruder is on campus.
